

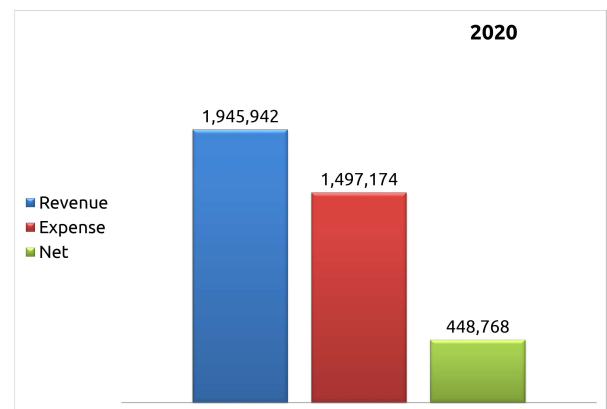
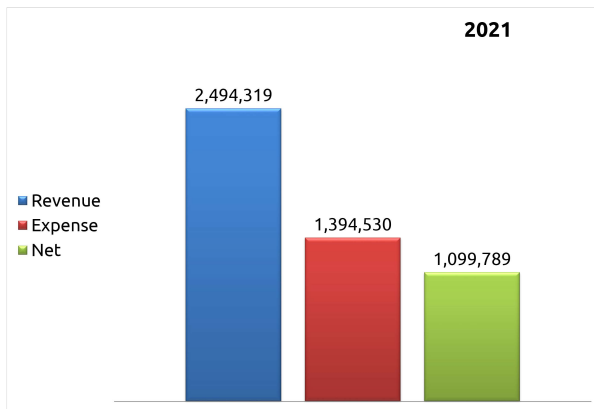

Information shown below is based on audited financial statements for the calendar years ended December 31, 2021 and 2020.

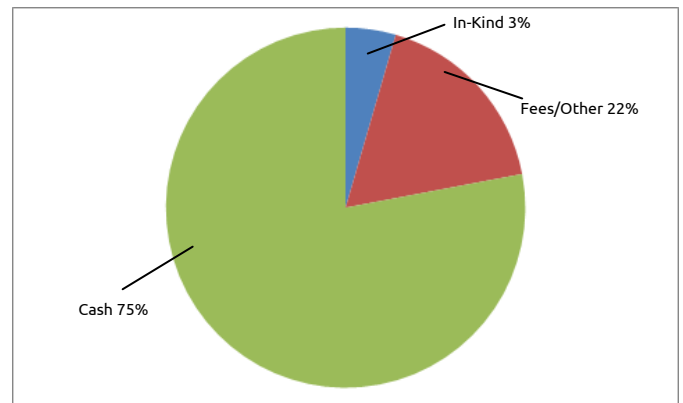
