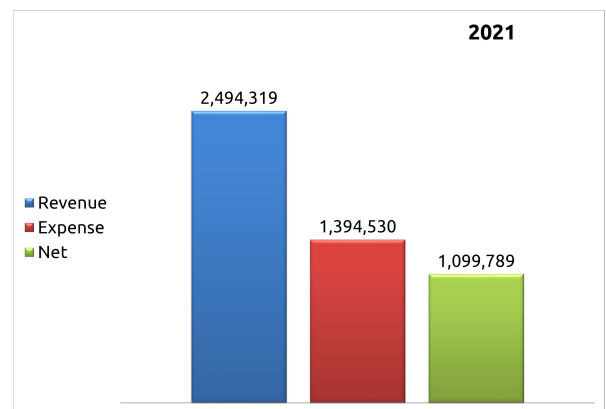
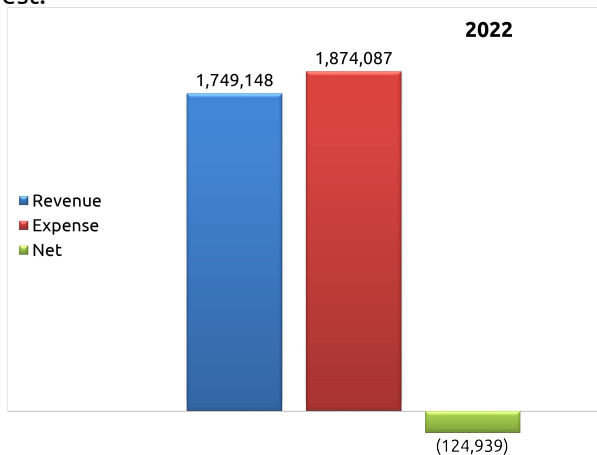

Information shown below is based on audited financial statements for the calendar years ended December 31, 2022 and 2021.

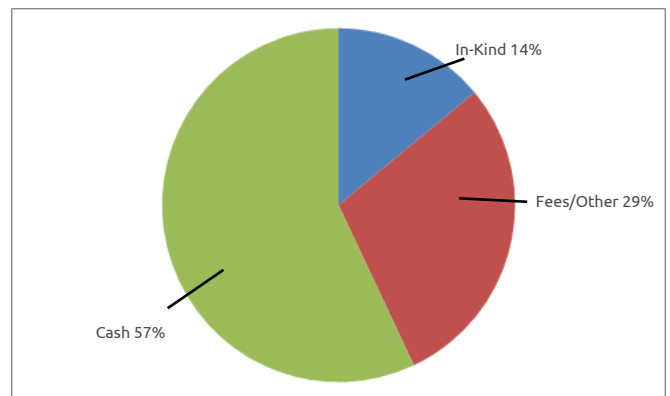
