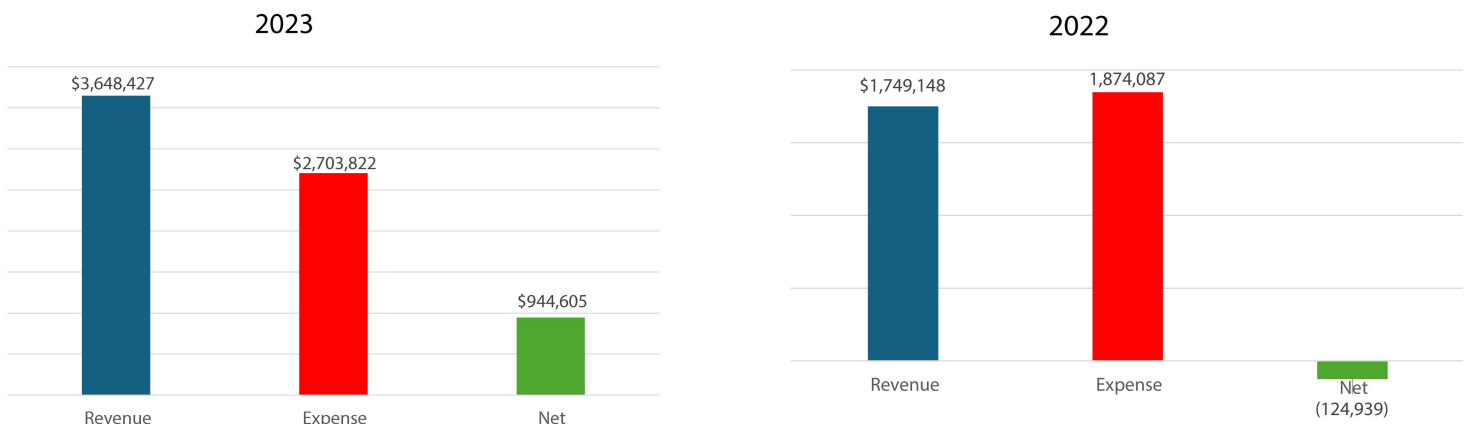

Information shown below is based on audited financial statements for the calendar years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022.

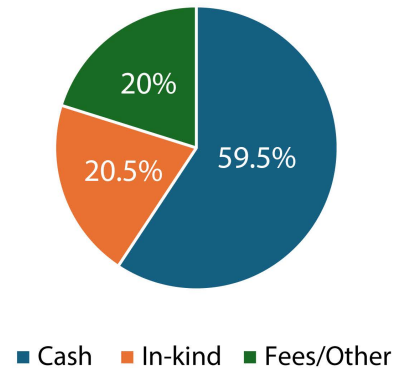
